Upcoming Execution: Advocacy & Vigil

The Commonwealth of Virginia plans to execute Ivan Teleguz on April 25, 2017. Teleguz was convicted and sentenced to death for ordering the murder of Stephanie Sipes. His co-defendant, who actually committed the murder, is serving a life sentence. Two of the prosecution's three main witnesses have admitted they lied at trial when they said that Teleguz was involved. Please contact Governor McAuliffe at <https://secure.vadp.org/page/speakout/stop-the-april-25-2017-execution-of-ivan-teleguz> to ask him to stop the execution and commute the death sentence to life in prison without the possibility of parole.

If the execution goes forward on April 25, you are invited to a vigil that evening sponsored by Virginians for Alternatives to the Death Penalty. The vigil will be from 8:45 to 9:15 pm in the Activity Room at the Unitarian Universalist Church of Arlington (4444 Arlington Blvd., Arlington, 22204).
